Notice Painting Competition on
the National Commemorations of March 25, 1821 and April 1, 1955

The National Cyprus Federation in cooperation with the Educational Mission of Cyprus and Greece Education Coordinator Office and educational institutions of the community, launches competition Painting for students of Greek Diaspora schools and all-day Greek schools on:

"March 25, 1821" - The **Greek War of Independence**, also known as the **Greek Revolution**

"April 1, 1955" - GREEK CYPRIOT REVOLUTION 1 APRIL 1955 (EOKA)

The competition is open to students of Greek Schools in Great Britain.

Projects submitted must be classified under the responsibility of the teaching staff of each school depending on the age of the students into three groups: 6-9 years, 10-12 years and 13-16 years. Each school is invited to submit only three projects from each age group. On the back of each work should give the particulars of / authors of: name, class, age, school name, telephone number, and the project title.

The three best projects from each age group will be awarded and will sculpt the pamparoiakiakou celebration program on National Anniversaries, to be held at Ashmole Academy, Cecil Road, Southgate, London, N14 5RJ, Sunday, March 20, 2016, at 3.30 m. m., where he will be awarded the prizes to the winners.

The works should be delivered to the Offices of the Cyprus Educational Mission until Monday, March 7, 2016.

Invited Managers / Director and teachers of Greek Schools to encourage the participation of their students in the competition and to timely deliver projects to choose.
